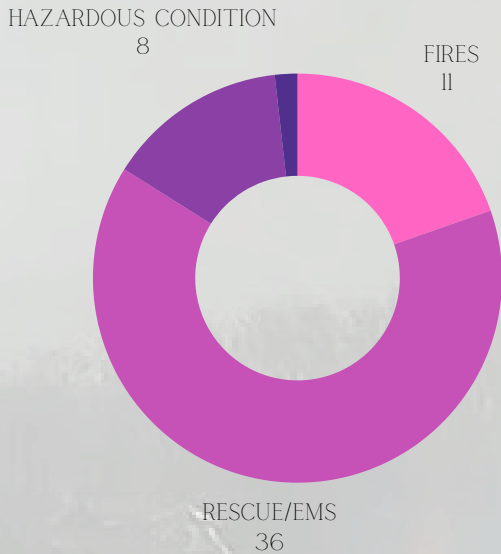

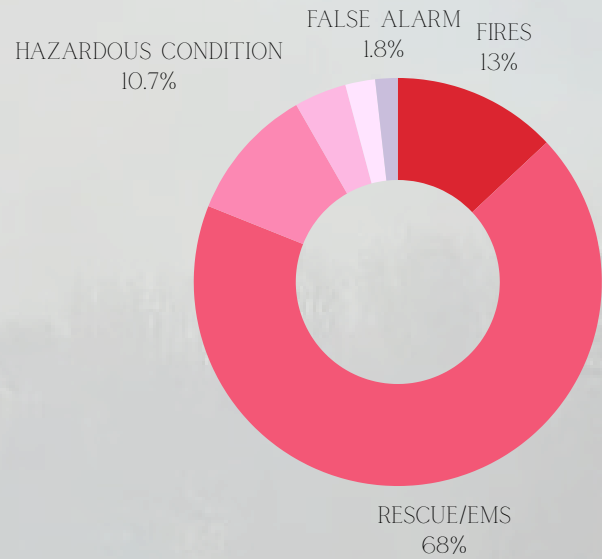

Monthly Breakdown

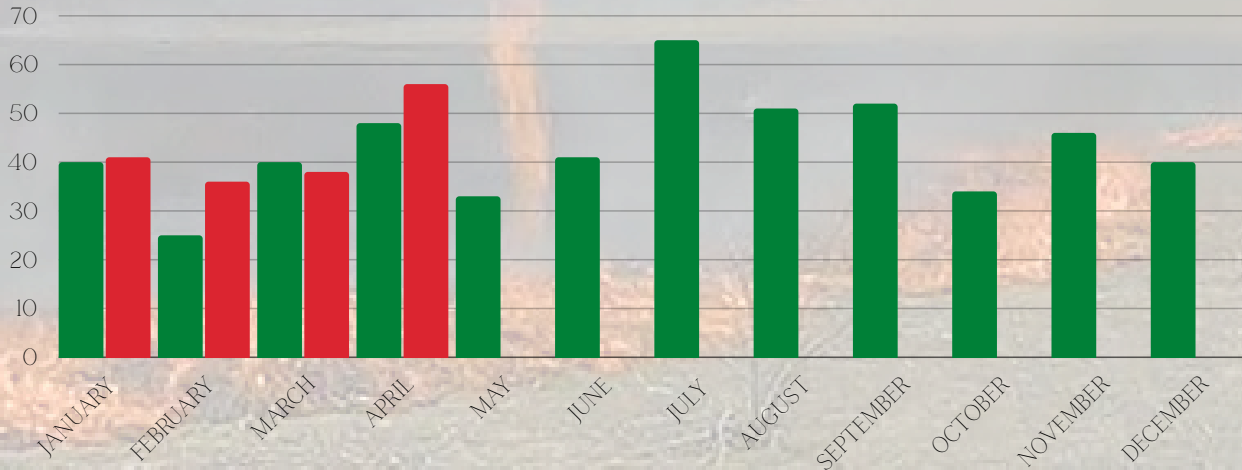


Yearly Totals

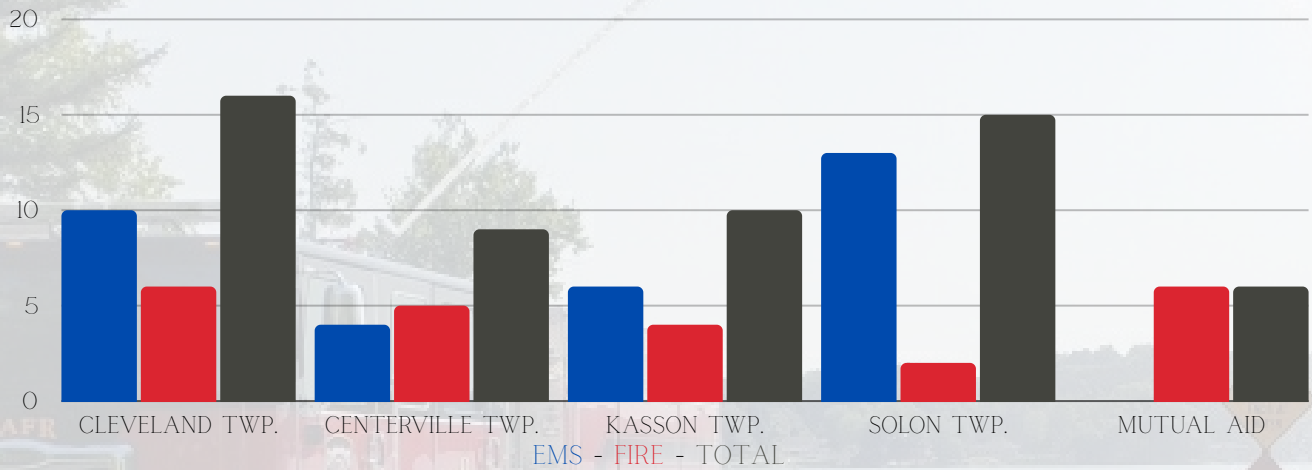


TOTAL CALLS FOR SERVICE YEAR-TO-DATE

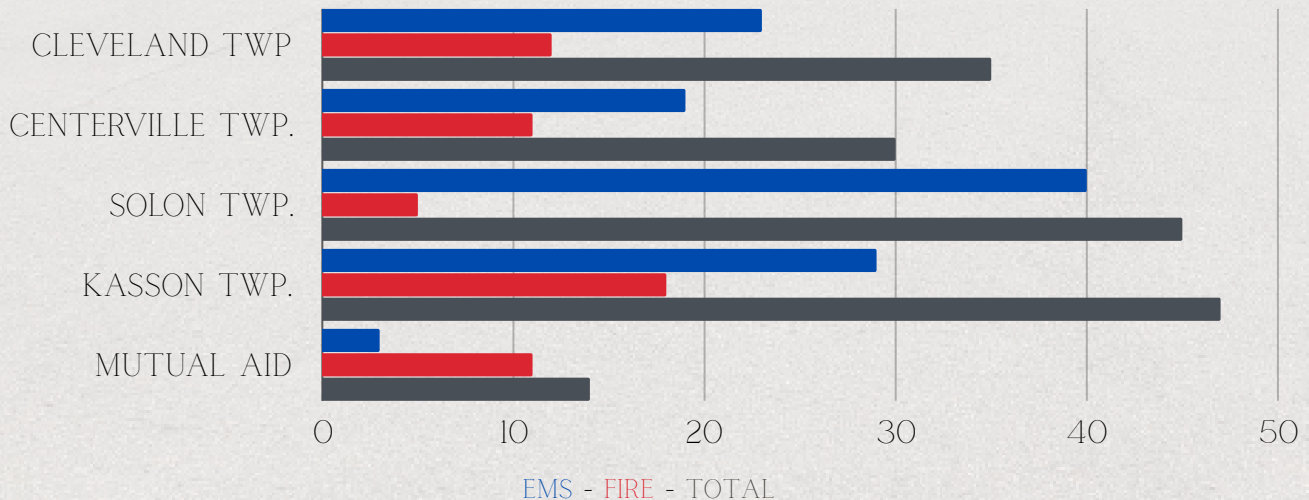
MONTHLY CALLS BY TOWNSHIP

A MESSAGE FROM THE CHIEF

WE RESPONDED TO 8 WILDLAND FIRES LAST MONTH OF VARYING SEVERITY. THIS IS THE TIME OF YEAR WHERE HISTORICALLY OUR SUMMER FIRE SEASON STARTS AND I'D SAY WE STARTED OFF PRETTY QUICKLY.

I'LL TAKE THIS TIME TO REMIND EVERYONE THAT WE FOLLOW THE STATE OF MICHIGAN OPEN BURNING GUIDANCE. EACH MORNING OUR CREWS GO TO WWW.DNR.STATE.MI.US/BURNPERMITS AND CHECK TO SEE IF BURNING WILL BE ALLOWED FOR THE DAY. AS A DEPARTMENT WE DON'T GIVE OUT PHYSICAL "PERMITS". WHEN YOU CALL ASKING IF YOU CAN BURN TODAY OUR YES OR NO DEPENDS ON WHAT THE MAP SAYS. WHILE WE DON'T GIVE OUT PERMITS WE STILL APPRECIATE YOUR CALLS AS WE PASS THAT INFORMATION ON TO OUR DISPATCH CENTER SO IF A CALL SHOULD COME IN FOR A FIRE IN YOUR AREA THEY WILL GIVE US AND ADDITIONAL RESPONDERS A HEADS UP THAT YOUR CONTROLLED BURN MAY BE THE REASON FOR THE CALL.
