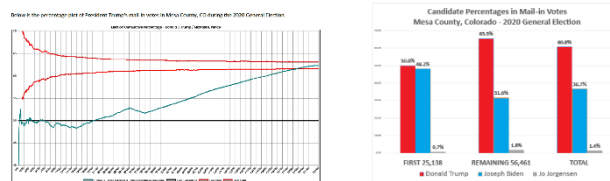

checks the Colorado District Attorney.

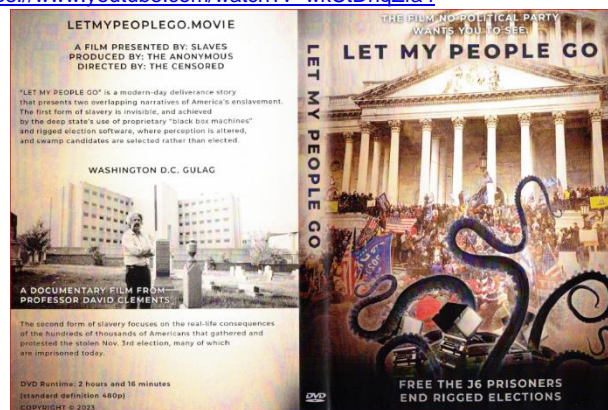
