**This picture was taken by a committee member during a trip to see wind projects in the Door Peninsula, Wisconsin. The Vesta wind turbines are about 290 feet high with blade diameters of 154 feet. The turbines were not turning when photographed, perhaps because of low wind speed. The township supervisor reported that, after many noise complaints, the public utility that owns these turbines agreed not to operate them when wind speeds are less than 9 miles per hour since noise is more noticeable at low wind speeds. Another committee member interviewed the residents, who told him they had been unable to sell their house.**
