Presentation by Joe DeFors - Overview of Energy Regulation: Electric Power markets and how they are sourced - Michigan is in MISO (Mid continent). Mission of MPSC discussed, illustrated. Tom Van Pelt offered knowledge of MISO, FERC (Fed Energy Regulation Commission) systems.

MPSC - Mich Public Service Commission - deals more with distribution to public at reasonable rates, FERC deals more with wholesale distribution.

Energy Regulation - Consumers Energy, for instance, is investor owned., is a regulated monopoly. Cooperative - Cherryland Electric.....member regulated Publicly owed - Traverse City Light & Power - owned by community Ann Arbor having discussion on whether to create a sustainable energy utility - in process.

Micro grids......being discussed but not available in Michigan as yet.
