TECHNICAL RESCUE

ON JUNE 11TH WE WERE PART OF A MABAS TECHNICAL RESCUE RESPONSE TO ELMWOOD TOWNSHIP. WE ASSISTED WITH THE RESCUE OF AN INJURED WORKER THAT WAS IN A CONFINED SPACE. WE RESPONDED ALONG WITH MEMBERS OF THE TRAVERSE CITY FIRE DEPARTMENT, GRAND TRAVERSE METRO FIRE DEPARTMENT AND ELMWOOD TOWNSHIP FIRE DEPARTMENT.




FIELD FIRE

Annual Call Comparison




TOTAL CALLS FOR SERVICE YEAR-TO-DATE


MONTHLY CALLS BY TOWNSHIP

I SAID LAST MONTH THAT SUMMER WAS RAMPING UP, WELL I CAN SAY THAT ITS OFFICIALLY HERE NOW!

WE HAVE SEEN AN UPTICK IN CALLS FOR SERVICE AS JUNE 2024 WAS OUR SECOND BUSIEST MONTH IN THE LAST TWO YEARS. WE ARE SEEING MANY OF OUR NORMAL CALLS FOR SERVICE BUT THEY ARE COMING WITH A GREATER QUANTITY. AS YOU CAN SEE IN THE MONTHLY NUMBERS LISTED A COUPLE PAGES AGO WE WERE NEARLY AN EVEN SPLIT FOR ALL OF OUR TOWNSHIPS IN CALLS FOR SERVICE LAST MONTH. I HAVE NOT EVER SEEN A MONTH END SO CLOSE TO EVEN FOR ALL OF OUR TOWNSHIPS.

IF YOU STOPPED AT THE HARDWARE LAST MONTH YOU MAY HAVE SEEN SOME CARS IN OUR PARKING LOT. OUR MEMBERS SPENT THE MONTH USING THESE CARS THAT WERE GENEROUSLY DONATED BY BINGHAM TOWING FOR VEHICLE EXTRICATION TRAINING. THIS TRAINING IS VERY VALUABLE AS WHEN IT IS NEEDED OUR ABILITY TO QUICKLY AND EFFICIENTLY DO WHAT WE NEED TO DO CAN GREATLY AFFECT OUR PATIENT OUTCOMES.
