

ELMWOOD CHARTER TOWNSHIP

Ordinance No. 2005-08

AN ORDINANCE FOR PERMITS FOR THE USE OF BOAT SLIPS AND MOORINGS AT THE TOWNSHIP MARINA AS PERMITTED BY MCLA 42.15 AND TO PROVIDE FOR MARINA RULES AND MARINA POLICY

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF ELMWOOD ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Marina Permits.

The Harbormaster of the township marina or the designee of the Harbormaster is authorized to issue a license, called a permit, for the dockage and mooring of boats at the township marina. Permits may be issued for a season or for summer storage or for such time periods as shall be authorized by marina policy or the township board.

SECTION 2. Marina Policy & Rules.

The Harbormaster in consultation with any committee appointed by the township board to make recommendations regarding the marina shall prepare marina policies and marina rules. The marina rules shall relate to the conduct of persons at the marina or the use of the marina by boaters and guests. The marina policy shall relate to the internal operation of the marina by township employees. The marina rules and marina policy shall be approved by the township board. All existing marina rules and policies that have previously approved by the township board need not be re-approved by the township board.

SECTION 3. Permit Provisions.

The permit form shall be approved by the township board. An approval of a permit form by the township board prior to the effective date of this ordinance need not be re-approved by the township board. A permit may be terminated as provided in the permit.

SECTION 4. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall become effective eight (8) days after publication.

The preceding ordinance was adopted at a special meeting of the Elmwood Township Board on November 22, 2005.
