Based on discussions with MVNH co-owner John Kasben Junior, Myles Kimmerly Park actually has a small, 4- to 5-foot underground chamber, rather than a septic tank. This cement vault is about three or four foot deep; with only pipes in it that run straight across. The drainfield is in two sections; a diverter valve was utilized every six months or so, they would switch and use the other side of the field.

Kasben stated he doesn't know if we have to remove the drainfield; the project should wait until the soil dries up, according to Environmental Health official Clay McNitt.
