My staff and I are not authorized to validate content on a document or check title. We do take pride in closely following the statutes that have been mandated by the state to assure records are being handled correctly.

When a document is recorded, it becomes a permanent public record. It cannot be removed, altered or changed.

As Register, I want to encourage our residents to sign up for the free fraud alert service we offer through our Tyler software. After you are signed up, the program will alert you if anything has been recorded in the public records under the name or names you register.

I would also like to invite our residents into the Register of Deeds office to see our process, ask questions and get a better understanding of what our offices does. Search your public records, and sign up for the free fraud alert service, if you haven't already done so.
