The following read <u>from notes</u> prepared <u>during meeting</u> and some from notes prepared earlier, at Second Public Comment period at end of this meeting.

We need help to understand commissions policy change tonight limiting Public Comment at Commission meetings. Need clarification public comment eliminated/limited at which BOC meetings. Wessel clarified: "1st public comment-Exec. Meeting limited to agenda items only."

All other meetings public comment on any matter(s)."

Do <u>commissioners</u> have a report for a 3 – 5 year period indicating the many hours of waste <u>their</u> 'precious' time? Or, violations the of public causing need/necessity for this change? Commissioners this year have wasted an hour on this issue trying fix something that's not/was **not broken**. Appears commissioners like the **Clerk-Loathing** action of May 11, 2021 made a <u>NON fact-based</u> decision to now <u>censor</u> the public. Apparently and 'honorable' thing to do? Appears commissioners are trying to find 'monsters/enemies' to destroy among people making public comment. *We request this board rescind its motion re public comment tonight, before this meeting ends...*

Our County Commissioner (Ross) witnessed **GOVERNMENT by INSANITY** last nite 8/15/23 at the **Leland Twp Board** meeting showing questionable/bad decision making—a unilateral tax increase without electors approval, etc. Electors/voters left out of the tax increase process by <u>unilaterally</u> imposing a **ONE (1)** % "administrative" fee. Seems obvious the **Board** can't manage Taxpayers money. How has the township survived for more than 100 years without an administrative fee? We advised the **Board** that such poor performance requires an new slate of candidates for the next election... We trust that our commissioner (ROSS) communicates last nite's **bad** government performance to her colleagues and Administrator.

The past two commissions appear to have poor leadership in one area. Recently we advised this BOC they ALL may be unfit for office for next election due to BOC's proceeding with the terrible/ tragic impact of the prior BOC's May 21, 2021 Clerk-Loathing decision (immediately removing all duties associated with Finance and Human Resources) causing a financial crises (recently criticized by Auditor Peacock) with collaboration from two other elected officials.
