## Purpose of the Public Hearing:

Closeout of the Leelanau County / CDBG Program Income (2021).

Purpose: afford citizens an opportunity to submit comments and receive a final report on the completion of the CDBG Program Income 2021 Emergency Repair grant.

Planning and Community Development Director Trudy Galla was present along with Leah Moskovitz, Financial and Grant Manager at NMCAA. Galla distributed the "Program Income Accomplishment Report" and addressed the Program Income Expenditures by Project and the Emergency Rehab Amount spent. Moskovitz also added comments on the funding. The form lays out where the funds were spent with two homes in Leelanau Township and one in Elmwood Township. Comments continued on the projects and the recipients.

Galla turned over the meeting to Moskovitz to offer comments on the utilization of the Government funds to help individuals and the repairs to keep them in their homes. She further expanded on the assistance received. She also commented on clients that are in the pipeline for potential assistance.
