Supervisor's Report

The purpose of this report is simply to update the board on the general, administrative-type work that goes on between regular board meetings.

While some of these matters may come before the board at some point, my intent is not to opine on any of them here — those sorts of discussions are more appropriate for the "Action Items" portion of the agenda.

Nor will this forum be used for any manner of politicking.

With only two weeks on the job, there is a fair amount to report.

I've had a number of meetings and discussions with staff, heads of committees and commissions, and board members, with more to come. I'm eager to dig in, and continue to work together, as we enter budgeting season.

For FY 2025 budgeting purposes, I received an estimate from PK Striping for painting on Reynolds Street and crosswalks near LPS. This work could be scheduled for early spring.

Clerk Brookfield and I had our first meeting with firefighters, pursuant to our current contract. That contract expires April 1. We received their initial proposal and had some preliminary discussions. Further talks will likely wait until after the first of the year.

I've received applications for the Planning Commission and ZBA, and a resignation from Board of Review. With Trustee Scales' election, we currently have an opening on the sewer commission. We can also add members to the parks and recreation committee. Otherwise, with tonight's appointments, all boards and commission are full.
