

CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF ELMWOOD

Ordinance No. 3 of 2004

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT BY REFERENCE THE UNIFORM TRAFFIC CODE FOR CITIES, TOWNSHIPS, AND VILLAGES.

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF ELMWOOD ORDAINS:

Section 1. Code and Amendment and Revisions adopted.

The Uniform Traffic Code for Cities, Townships, and Villages are promulgated by the director of the Michigan Department of State Police pursuant to the Administrative Procedures Act of 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 to 24.328 and made effective October 30, 2002, and all future amendments and revisions to the Uniform Traffic Code when they are promulgated and effective in this state are incorporated and adopted by reference.

Section 2. References in Code.

References in the Uniform Traffic Code for Cities, Townships, and Villages to a "governmental unit" shall mean Elmwood Charter Township.

Section 3. Notice to be Published.

The Elmwood Charter Township clerk shall publish this ordinance in the manner required by law and shall publish, at the same time, a notice stating the purpose of the Uniform Traffic Code for Cities, Townships, and Villages and the fact that a complete copy of the code is available to the public at the office of the clerk for inspection.

Section 4. Repeal.

The Uniform Traffic Code for Cities, Townships, and Villages previously enacted by Elmwood Charter Township is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 5. Penalties.

The penalties provided by the Michigan Vehicle Code are adopted by reference.

Section 6. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its publication in a newspaper of general circulation within the township.
